VBS and RE Gifts – Sacred Heart Parish

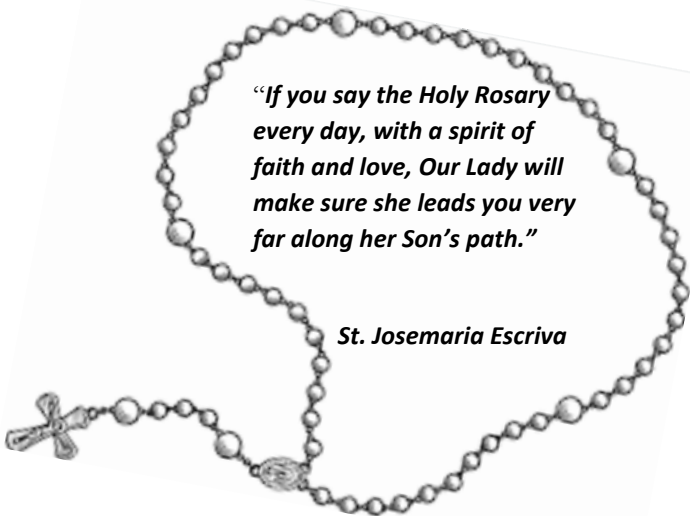
